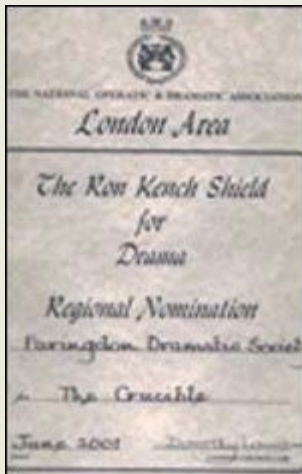


The Crucible
