Debbie Lock - Director

Debbie has been with FDS since 1987. She has appeared in a variety of productions and has directed many plays and pantomimes: most recently **Cider With Rosie** in 2017, and **Faringdon Follies** (at Buscot Park Theatre) in 2018. You may be forgiven for thinking she's as much on stage as behind the scenes: she has been a pantomime knight, a magic talking mirror, played six separate parts in **The Farndale Avenue Murder Mystery**, and (in **Our Country's Good** last November) as a feisty female convict in Australia. Another of Debbie's talents is choreography and when she has not been directing a panto has often been responsible for the dance moves.



Principal Characters

Miriam Wells (Aladdin)

"I started performing in FDS pantomimes at the age of nine and performed in various productions including roles as Anna in **Dreamers** and Wendy in **Peter Panto** back in 2008. Whilst living in Plymouth, I was part of the Southwest Philharmonia and Chorus and performed both classical and musical scores including a 'Last night of the Proms' evening. Having recently returned to Faringdon I am delighted to rejoin the society and take on this exciting role!"



Verity Roberts (Widow Twankey)

Verity has taken leading roles in **The Importance of Being Earnest** (2007 - her first), **Cold Comfort Farm** and **The Odd Couple**, and was Hermia in 2013's outdoor production of **A Midsummer Night's Dream**. She has had significant parts in no fewer than eight of our last ten pantos, most recently **Dick Whittington** in 2018. Verity was co-author (with Helen Thrower) of the panto **Happily Ever After** in 2016 and **Wishing on a Star** in 2019.

Adrian Wells (Genie of the Lamp)

Adrian has been a part of FDS since 1995. He has been in award winning productions including **The Crucible**, and has enjoyed a variety of roles in plays by Shakespeare, Chekhov, Wilde and Ayckbourn. He's often been a "baddie" in pantomime so playing Alderman Fitzwarren in **Dick Whittington** and now a Genie has made a welcome change. Adrian has also designed most of our publicity posters and programme covers.



Millie Long (Genie of the Ring)

Millie has been taking part in FDS pantomimes since **The Snow Queen** in 2015 and was Laurie Lee's sister Phyll in **Cider with Rosie** (2017). Her first lead role was as Alice Fitzwarren in **Dick Whittington** (2018) and was Louisa in **Wishing on a Star** last year. Millie has also been involved in the Shakespeare Schools Festival with a performance of **Macbeth** in Swindon's Wyvern Theatre.

Jacob Bayliss (Abraxas)

In 2018 we saw Jacob on stage playing the part of a new member of FDS in **Faringdon Follies** (basically, himself!) and in **Wishing on a Star** in 2019. His debut actually came when he stepped in at short notice to take a couple of small roles in **Cider with Rosie** (2017), one of which entailed him being beaten to death! Last year was his first appearance in Panto so he is now an old hand at it.



Katie Dyet (Sultana)

Katie's first appearance was as one of the Kit Kat Girls in **Cabaret** (2002) and since then she has appeared in too many shows to mention. Her panto highlights might be when she performed as the Evil Queen in **Happily Ever After** and Jack Frost in **The Snow Queen**. Other plays she has been in include **Candleford**, **Wife After Death**, **My Friend Miss Flint** and **Dick Whittington**. Katie has been the committee chair of FDS and has taken numerous roles behind the scenes.



Dexter Kent (Vizier)

Dexter is 11 years old and attends Faringdon Community College. This is his third pantomime with FDS and last summer he had his professional stage debut at Blenheim Palace's Shakespeare Rose Theatre, as Prince York in **Richard III**. Dexter also appears as an extra in the musical film **Perfectly Frank**. He has a scholarship at West Oxfordshire Academy of Performing Arts and hopes to appear in more productions throughout this year.

Kia Howard (Princess Pearl)

Kia has been performing with FDS since age the age of 10 with **The Snow Queen**. She has been involved in numerous performances since including **Cider with Rosie** (as Rosie, 2017) and **Chitty Chitty Bang Bang** at the Wyvern theatre just recently. After studying Drama and Dance for GCSE subjects, Kia hopes to go on to developing a career in performing arts. She has thoroughly enjoyed the experience of playing the princess in this year's performance and hopes you enjoy it as much as she has.



Alison Morris (Fumble)

Alison lives in Witney and in 2017 made her debut as Laurie Lee's sister Marge in **Cider with Rosie**. For ten years Alison has been a member of two choirs, taking roles in sketches and musicals with Witney Inter-Church Singers, and played Ratty in the St Mary's Church production of **Wind in the Willows**. **Wishing on a Star** (as Prince Odo) last year was her first go at pantomime, and she thoroughly enjoyed it. More recently Alison was a cocktail waitress in **Shakers**, staged for Follyfest 2019.

Lynne Puddifoot (Blunder)

Lynne has performed in FDS pantos for several years now: she was Merlin's rather cynical owl in **Arthur's Adventure** (2017), a cat in **Dick Whittington** (2018) and a minstrel in **Wishing on a Star** (2019). Every time she has had a lot of fun, from auditions through rehearsals, fittings, and final performance! Lynne finds performing a great alternative outlet for her artistic expression and is looking forward to many more rôles treading the boards.



Faringdon Dramatic Society

Since its formation in 1948 Faringdon Dramatic Society has mounted over 150 productions, ranging from pantomime to dramas, comedies to Shakespeare. We have carried off a number of awards including the NODA Flame Award for **Heroes** in 2010: 'for inspirational contribution to the pursuit of excellence in Theatre'. **The Crucible** (2001) and **Dancing at Lughnasa** (2004) both won best drama production in London and the South East area from NODA.

We have won four of the last six pantomime competitions run by the Oxfordshire Drama network. The most recent was for **Arthur's Adventure** in 2017.

Our current membership is around 60, but new members are always welcome; there are opportunities for backstage / front of house personnel as well as actors.

Our next production is **Ladies Day**, by Amanda Whittington, at Buscot Park Theatre, July 1-4. This play will also be taken to Garrison Little Theatre, Fort Erie, Canada as part of our regular theatre exchange.
